When writing this letter, it is best to make sure that your subject clearly informs that you are sending an invitation to an interview over the phone. (Otherwise, candidates may assume the worst and not open your message.) Keep your message brief. Mention the position you are interviewing and the timing of the interview. You can also use the same template for a video or Skype interview. Long gone are the structured wedding clerical rules (where all invitations were white or ecru with a black engraved script), a change that instilled in the wedding industry, with a new life. One thing that hasn't changed? Wedding invitation etiquette. Wedding invitation etiquette provides simple rules to allow any bride to effectively communicate the details of their wedding by doing so in a polite, respectful manner. You should: Include basic details such as the names of the bride and groom, as well as the place and date of the ceremony. This is obvious to most, but you would be surprised by the number of brides who order their invitations without this information prepared. If you order online without the help of a consultant, triple check to make sure you have this information. Protector everything! While working as a consultant for wedding stationery, take a close look at the spelling and placement of the text. Don't be a bride who only gives look at the evidence, only to realize your mistake as soon as the final prints are made. What is through your wording who is holding the ceremony. When the invitation reads: Mr. and Mrs. Robert Smith ask for the honor of your presence in the marriage of their daughter, Susan Marie, it is subtly stated that the bride's parents will be hosting (i.e. pay for) the event. Couples today have options for wording because the rules for wedding hosting have changed: the bride's parents, the groom's parents, both parent sets, the couple or the combination above may be potential hosts. Just make sure to give credit where the loan is due, and use the appropriate wording. Be consistent throughout the invitation package. If you have a more formal wedding (and thus a more formal invitation), write out all the numbers, including dates, times and years. So instead of putting Friday, August 15, 2013 at 3 p.m., you want to write Friday, August 15th, two thousand thirteen at three o'clock in the afternoon. It's verbose, but for an official invitation, it adds a sense of elegance. For more random invitations, you may prefer to write out numbers, but it is a matter of personal preference. Whatever you do on the occasional invite, make sure you do it consistently. Know when to send individual invitations. For family groups with children under the age of eighteen, it is good to send one invitation to all. However, if there is a family group with children over the age of eighteen who are still living at home, every child over the age of eighteen should receive a separate invitation. Couples, whether they are married or not, should receive one invitation if they live at the same address. Young people who do not meet but are still together should receive individual invitations. Send your invitations six to eight weeks before the wedding ceremony and reception. Any earlier will cause your wedding invites you to arrive too close to your save-the-dates and anyone later can interfere with the ability of guests to get time off work, organize childcare, or book hotel rooms. You should avoid: Trying to squeeze information about the reception at the bottom of the wedding invite. Yes, you'll save money on an extra shell card, but the overall effect will be confusing for your guests. The ceremony and reception are two separate events, and thus their information should be on completely separate pieces of paper. Ask or refer to (in any case) for gifts or money. Gifts should be a symbol of appreciation of your guests, so it is extremely inappropriate to ask them. Avoid including registry information anywhere in your wedding suite. The best place to put this will be on your wedding site with links to the registries. Other phrases to hold under from your invitation: all that mention is a tree of money or cash Such desires should be passed along orally to select friends and family members who can then inform guests of your preferences if asked. Print information the back of the invitation. If you want to include hotel information, the URL of your wedding site, or directions to the venue, just order another case card with that information.
